(●) Students will be awarded three ECTS if they either:

- pass a test or submit an official certification (including all the four areas of evaluation: reading, writing, listening and speaking) assessing their knowledge of English language at a higher level than that certified as admission requirement (e.g.: at least C1 - according to Common European Framework of Reference for Languages - if the admission requirement was fulfilled with a B2 level; C2, if the admission requirement was fulfilled with a C1 level) ; **or**
- pass a test or submit an official certification (including all the four areas of evaluation: reading, writing, listening and speaking) assessing their knowledge of another language other than English or the student's native language – which may be Italian for foreign students – at level at least B1 according to Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.

**N.B.:** Other Language Activities are intended to allow students to have an improvement in their language skills over the course. This means that the credits only will be awarded if the relevant situation has improved after the enrolment of the students. As a fallout of such a principle, native English-speaking students and students coming from Countries having English as an official language are not allowed to have the Other Language Activities credits awarded in the English language.

Specific short courses for English, French, German, Spanish and Italian Languages will be offered by the UniMC Language Centre.

(\*) Students should be aware that, although the LLB *IECoLS* has no formal specialising streams, an accurate choice among these modules contributes to the development of a more focused grounding. In particular:

- “Data Protection, Privacy and Internet Law”, “Environmental Law”, “EU Food Law” & “Conflict of Laws” lead to a focus on **Transnational Law**;
- “Data Protection, Privacy and Internet Law”, “Maritime Law Evolving”, “Conflict of Laws” & “Global Markets, Sustainability and Digitalization” focus on **International Business**.

(\*\*) Modules, seminars, and other. Students can be awarded the required ECTS also by taking any of the modules taught at UniMC in English Language if it is held consistent with the LLB Programme. The module Migration Law, s.s.d. IUS/13, 40 hours, 8 ECTS, taught in the 5-year LLM Programme in Jurisprudence, and all the elective modules in Year 3 that have not been taken by the student, are pre-approved as consistent with the IECOLS LLB Programme.
